DIRECTIONS: From York, take I-83 South to exit 4. Stay left on ramp and turn left towards Stewartstown onto Rt. 851 East. Continue into Stewartstown to stop sign. Turn left on Rt. 24 North. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right on Hickory Road. Continue about 1.6 miles to "T", and turn left. Take 1st right again onto Hickory Road. Go about 4 tenths of a mile and turn left (Blue Building on your right)—still on Hickory Rd. Go about 1.3 miles and go left—again on Hickory Rd. Heartwood Nursery is located about ½ mile down on the left side (directly across from the E. Hopewell Twp. Building) – look for a group of mailboxes, the 1st one shows 8951 and turn left. Following the fence on the right side, turn right into the 2nd set of green gates – #8957. You will receive parking instructions upon entry.

Driving directions to Doyle Farm Nursery will be available at this site.

DETAILS: Native trees, shrubs, ground covers and ferns, and selected American and holly liners will be available for sale.

OWNER'S DESCRIPTION: Heartwood Nursery, Inc. is a family business founded in 1992. Previously located in Monkton, Maryland, the entire nursery including containers and the propagation facility have been moved to the main location just over the Maryland line near Stewartstown PA.

We specialize in woody propagation and native woody propagation. A significant amount of our inventory is propagated on site using local seed and cutting sources. The size of plant material offered for sale ranges from 6-12" containerized plants and liners, to 1.5 to 12 inch caliper BB field-grown trees. In ground pricing is available upon request on BB material 4-5 inches caliper and larger.

COMMENTS: We will have a propagation demonstration at 2:00 pm, a digging demonstration (weather permitting) and a pruning demonstration.
